No Signs of Recent Avalanches

We rode through Sunlight Basin, Sage Basin, and Cabin Creek today looking for avalanche activity from the most recent storm that dropped 15" of snow (1.5" of <u>snow water equivalent</u>) in the Taylor Fork area. We did not see any signs of recent avalanches. Today the wind blew from the NE, and it was drifting the new storm snow throughout Cabin Creek and Sage Basin. Since the wind is transporting the storm snow it is still possible to <u>trigger</u> an avalanche several days after the storm.
