Still weak in Island Park

We snowmobiled up to 9,000' on Sawtelle peak, then skied to dig a couple pits. Our first pit was on an East aspect on a heavily wind loaded slope. The HS was 130cm (or 4.2 feet). There was 8" of new snow equal to 0.85" SWE, sitting over old consolidated snow that made up a <u>slab</u> over soft, weak facets about 50cm off the ground. We had ECTP24 x2 break on the old weak snow. Our second put was on a SW <u>aspect</u> and had an HS of 90cm (almost 3 feet). We got an ECTP19 here breaking on the same layer of very soft, weak facets. Wind was moderate out of the west-northwest with temps in the teens F. The new snow combined with the poor snow structure will increase avalanche danger this weekend. Video attached.
